1	Lucy Johns	LANES: Where does patient consent enter into the workflow?	At the clinics, patient consent is collected and transmitted electronically to our HIE (LANES) via ADT feeds. For WIC referrals, clinics are only allowed to share limited clinical information related to WIC services. Since WIC agencies are non-covered entities, they do not obtain patient consent and do not sharing WIC services with clinics.
2	Lucy Johns	On slide 28: Where is identity management? In here somewhere?	Within the Roadmap, identity management is a cross-pillar consideration. There are recommendations associated with identity management in many of the pillars.
3	Lucy Johns	Gravity Project doing standards for health/social care exchange for several years. Anything useful there for issues Sophie Chang is describing so well?	Likely yes. As Sophia said, the intent is to leverage national standards and national initiatives like Gravity whenever possible. We are monitoring Gravity.
4	Lucy Johns	Great thanks. DirectTrust also striving to refine such exchange with active committee. Plus informal cross-org group starting up soon. Lots of people working on this. ;-)	--

6	Ray Duncan (CSHS)	TEFCA also tightened up the vetting process for participants in reaction to the CareQuality dispute.	Thank you, Ray.

7	Leslie Witten-Rood	Yes adding Skilled Nursing would be helpful and expand use case of the ePolst Registry	Thank you, Leslie.
